TWO DAY'S MASS CASUAL LEAVE ACTION ON 5th & 6th SEPTEMBER 2018

PREPARE ONE. PREPARE ALL

The United Forum of Reserve Bank Officers & Employees (UFRBOE) met at Mumbai on 3rd August 2018. Sarvashri Ajay Sinha, Rajdeep Chakrabarty (RBIOA), Keshav Jagtap, Smt. Chitra Patankar, C M Paulsil, M D Sawant (AIRBOA), Ajit Subhedar, Xavier Lobo, Pradip Kadam, Samir Wadkar (AIRBEA), S V Mahadik, R M Palande and B G Yerwankar (AIRBWF) along with others attended. Com S V Mahadik was in the chair. The meeting was held as a sequel to the decisions of the UFRBOE, as spelt out in the Circular dated 20th April, 2018 and also, after the conclusion of the Mass Signature Campaign, by submission of the signatures collected to the RDs, at all centres on the 15th June, 2018 and after awaiting for the submission to the Governor, Dr. Urjit Patel, of all the signatures collected from all over India, which till date has not been submitted to the Governor, as the Governor has yet to find time to receive the Signatures with the Memorandum; the UFRBOE decided to meet, take stock of the situation and chalk out the future course of agitation culminating into a two day's Mass Casual Leave Action.

The meeting deliberated in detail and decided to continue and intensify the agitation and also to carry out the following programmes leading to two day's Mass Casual Leave Action on 5th & 6th September 2018:

- (a) On the eve of the Central Board Meeting at Mumbai, on Wednesday, 8th August 2018, an Appeal to be presented to the members of the Central Board and as usual demonstration to be held there on issues of pension updation, one more option for pension to CPF retainers and allow CPF / APF for those recruited from 2012.
- (b) On 20th August 2018, All India Gate Demonstration during lunch-time will be observed at all centres.
- (c) On 27th August 2018, as part of the All India programme, Memorandum to be presented to RDs at all centres.
- (d) Observe two day's All India Mass Casual Leave Action on 5th and 6th September 2018.

The UFRBOE meeting also decided to request retirees in all offices to extend full support to the programmes given above including the 8th August 2018 programme at Mumbai. These programmes will be preceded and followed by intensive press / media publicity to highlight our issues before the entire nation. Trade unions, peoples' representatives, etc. may be requested to extend their support.

The United Forum appeals to all sections of staff, retirees to enthusiastically participate in the programmes chalked out and the two day's Mass Casual Leave Action, to clinch the issues to a finality instead of allowing the Government to play with our patience and sense of responsibility ad infinitum. It is also observed that the Bank's Top Management despite their support to our pension related issues all along falters to take positive and correct steps in the face of intransigence of DFS, MoF, GOI and thus prolongs the denial to RBI staff and retirees which can not perpetuate and has to be resisted.

It is only our collective efforts that can ensure and safeguard our future.
